EXPECTED BEHAVIOUR - THE BENCHMARK THE BASICS

Unless you have something nice to say - don't say it

Encouragement is supported – be positive, be vocal

Do not engage in negative behaviour – be it in defence or retaliation. Report any negative conduct to the ground official and the club.

Refrain from challenging referee decisions – in fact, limit any engagement with the officials – they are human and can and will make mistakes – we are losing officials to our game as result of offensive and abusive behaviour – it is not necessary and will not be tolerated.

Special focus on the younger game leaders – they are young and learning – thank them for their efforts and contribution and encourage this behaviour among your players and supporters. They will be our officials of tomorrow. The better the environment for them to learn, then better they will become – that's not say that you need to "correct" or challenge their decisions explicitly – have a quiet word to the game leader mentor / supervisor at an appropriate time if you feel the need to support and contribute in some capacity.



EXPECTED BEHAVIOUR - THE BENCHMARK THE BASICS

Questioning a decision or offering "tips" is still challenging – if you need clarity have a subtle word with the officials at an appropriate time – you set the example for your players and spectators.

If an official's conduct is questionable, report it to the club – the club will make the decision on whether to escalate it. There has been instant where a pattern of behaviour was emerging, and it was handled diligently.

A split second of madness costs our volunteers time and effort that is better spent making our club better and providing the best possible service to our members – not to mention the impact this has on our reputation. We want to be the club where officials and other clubs are happy to attend. The apologies and regrets are too late – think before you speak and act.
